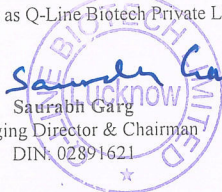
Notes on Standalone Financial Result for the Half year and Year ended 31st March, 2026:-

- 1 The above result have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and have been approved by the Board of Directors of the company at their
respective meetings held on 17th June, 2026.
- 2 The results for the year ended 31st March, 2026 has been audited by the statutory auditor of the company in compliance with regulation 33 of
SEBI(listing obligations and disclosure requirements) regulation, 2015.
- 3 The figure for the half year ended March 31.2026, as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in
respect of full financial year and the Unaudited figures for the period April 1, 2025 to September 30, 2025. The figure for the half year ended
March 31 2025, as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the
Unaudited figures for the period April 1, 2024 to September 30, 2024. Unaudited Figures for the half year ended Sept 2024, and Sept 2025 has
been extracted from the management certified financial for the half year ended 30th Sept, 2024 and 30th Sept 2025.
- 4 As per Accounting standard 17 on "segment Reporting" (AS-17), the company is having two segments i.e. Manufacturing and Trading into
Biochemistry Reagents, Instruments and Consumables and accordingly segment disclosures has been given in result.
- 5 As per the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) notification dated 16th February, 2015, companies whose shares are listed on the SME
Exchange as referred to in Chapter IX of SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 are exempted from the
compulsory requirement of adoption of Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS). Accordingly, the Company continues to prepare its financial
statements under Indian GAAP (AS framework), and these results have been presented in compliance with the aforesaid exemption.
- 6 Earnings per share have been computed in accordance with Accounting Standard (AS) 20 – Earnings Per Share, notified under the Companies
(Accounting Standards) Rules, 2006. Basic EPS and Diluted EPS are calculated on the basis of the weighted average number of equity shares
outstanding during the year. EPS is disclosed before extraordinary items and after extraordinary items, as required under AS 20, to present both
the underlying performance and the total impact on shareholders. The weighted average number of shares is adjusted for any bonus issue, rights
issue (including the bonus element therein), to ensure comparability across reporting periods.
- 7 The balance of Trade Payables, Trade Receivables, Loans and Advances, Deposits, Current Liabilities etc. are considered as per books of
account, pending confirmations and reconciliation. In the Opinion of the management, since the amount due to/ from these parties are fully
payable/recoverable, no material difference is expected to arise at the time of settlement, requiring accounting effect as on 31-03-2026.
- 8 On November 21, 2025, the Government of India notified the four Labour Codes - the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code,
2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 - consolidating 29 existing
labour laws. The Ministry of Labour & Employment published draft Central Rules and FAQs to enable assessment of the financial impact due
to changes in regulations. The Company has assessed the same & taken the necessary impact of these changes and to the best information
available, consistent with the guidance provided by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The Company continues to monitor the
finalisation of Central/ State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of the Labour Code and would provide appropriate
accounting effect (if any) on the basis of such developments if needed.
- 9 Previous year's/ period's figure have been regrouped/rearranged wherever necessary to make them comparable with the current year figures.

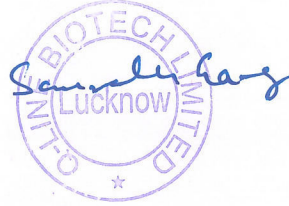

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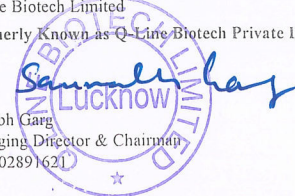

Notes on Consolidated Financial Result for the Half year and Year ended 31st March, 2026:-

- 1 The above result have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and have been approved by the Board of Directors of the company at their respective meetings held on 17th June, 2026.
- 2 The results for the year ended 31st March, 2026 has been audited by the statutory auditor of the company in compliance with regulation 33 of SEBI(listing obligations and disclosure requirements) regulation, 2015.
- 3 The figure for the half year ended March 31 2026, as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the Unaudited figures for the period April 1, 2025 to September 30, 2025. The figure for the half year ended March 31 2025, as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the Unaudited figures for the period April 1, 2024 to September 30, 2024. Unaudited Figures for the half year ended Sept 2024, and Sept 2025 has been extracted from the management certified financial for the half year ended 30th Sept, 2024 and 30th Sept 2025.
- 4 As per Accounting standard 17 on "segment Reporting" (AS-17), the company is having two segments i.e. Manufacturing and Trading into Biochemistry Reagents, Instruments and Consumables and accordingly segment disclosures has been given in result.
- 5 As per the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) notification dated 16th February, 2015, companies whose shares are listed on the SME Exchange as referred to in Chapter IX of SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 are exempted from the compulsory requirement of adoption of Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS). Accordingly, the Company continues to prepare its financial statements under Indian GAAP (AS framework), and these results have been presented in compliance with the aforesaid exemption.
- 6 Earnings per share have been computed in accordance with Accounting Standard (AS) 20 – Earnings Per Share, notified under the Companies (Accounting Standards) Rules, 2006. Basic EPS and Diluted EPS are calculated on the basis of the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year. EPS is disclosed before extraordinary items and after extraordinary items, as required under AS 20, to present both the underlying performance and the total impact on shareholders. The weighted average number of shares is adjusted for any bonus issue, rights issue (including the bonus element therein), to ensure comparability across reporting periods.
- 7 The balance of Trade Payables, Trade Receivables, Loans and Advances, Deposits, Current Liabilities etc. are considered as per books of account, pending confirmations and reconciliation. In the Opinion of the management, since the amount due to/ from these parties are fully payable/recoverable, no material difference is expected to arise at the time of settlement, requiring accounting effect as on 31-03-2026.
